



Terms & Conditions

Our Nevada Judges provides a community for the general public to evaluate the competence of the Nevada judiciary.

1. Definitions

A *bot* is an automated (i.e. non-human) client interacting with the website.

A *visitor* is a human client interacting with the website.

A *user* is a visitor who has registered an account on the website, and is logged in.

A *vendor* is a third-party entity which Our Nevada Judges servers interacts with and mines data from.

2. Adherence

A bot, visitor, and user must accept and adhere to these terms and conditions if they wish to use the Our Nevada Judges website.

3. YouTube

Our Nevada Judges uses YouTube's API to develop and render metrics. A bot, visitor, and user must accept and adhere to the YouTube Terms of Service if they wish to use the Our Nevada Judges website.

4. Services Provided

Our Nevada Judges provides an article, case, endorsement, video, and channel repository, as well as community for visitors and users to participate in.

5. Compensation

All services are provided free of charge. A visitor or user may donate if they choose to. No data obtained¹ from visitors and users is sold. Google automatically deploys ads to the website and diverts ad revenue to Our Nevada Judges. Bots, visitors, and users are encouraged to click on Google ads when there is a genuine interest; clicking on ads to artificially increase revenue provided to Our Nevada Judges is prohibited as it may constitute defrauding Google's marketing clients.

6. Ownership

There is no warranty as to the subject-matter discussed in articles², case dispositions³, and video metadata⁴ that is displayed as this data is automatically retrieved from vendors and verification and maintenance of any such data is through the vendor from which it is retrieved.

8. Complaints

9. Termination

Our Nevada Judges may delete a user for any non-discriminatory reason. Our Nevada Judges may ban a visitor's access for any non-discriminatory reason. A user may request deletion of their account by emailing admin@ournevadajudges.com. A visitor may terminate their relationship with Our Nevada Judges by ceasing their interaction with the website.

10. Dispute Resolution

The laws of the State of Nevada and the United States of America govern the contract, as jurisdictional principles allow. Legal disputes shall be settled through the Henderson Justice Court, Eighth Judicial District Court, and United States District Court, as provided by statutes, court rules, administrative regulations, and case precedent.

² Articles are retrieved from approved publishers. It is presumed that the reporter or journalist acted in a professional capacity in conducting their investigation. If it is brought to Our Nevada Judges that an article is patently false, however, it will be removed. Only publishers who consistently produce credible content are approved.

³ Case dispositions are retrieved from the Supreme Court of Nevada. Though visitors may have personal disagreements with the outcomes in these cases, it is not the role of Our Nevada Judges to editorialize the dispositions.
