WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION


This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition seeks to lift a stay imposed by the district court on all proceedings related to petitioner's claim and delivery complaint.


We have reviewed the petition and answer, and we conclude that our intervention by way of extraordinary writ is not warranted. On August 5, 2004, petitioner advised this court that the stay has been lifted.

Therefore, we are not able to grant the relief requested, and this petition is moot.¹ Accordingly, we
