
ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF PROHIBITON


This original petition for a writ of prohibition challenges separate district court orders denying petitioners' motion to dismiss a complaint for failure to serve defendants within 120 days and petitioner Joshua Michael Kliewer's motion to quash service of process.
