ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR
PROHIBITION

This original proper person petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges the Nevada Department of Corrections's refusal to allow petitioner to submit work written on 8 ½ x 14 paper for reduction and copying onto 8 ½ x 11 paper.
