


ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF
MANDAMUS AND/OR PROHIBITION


This original petition for a writ of mandamus and/or prohibition challenges a district court order that denied two motions: (1) petitioner's motion to extend the time of expert witness list exchange and to extend discovery, and (2) petitioner's motion to continue or re-set the trial date. Having considered this petition, we are not satisfied that this

court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted.¹
Accordingly, we deny the petition.²
