ORDER DENYING PETITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus, prohibition or certiorari challenges criminal proceedings pending below against petitioners alleging extortion in violation of NRS 205.320. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Jackie Glass, Judge.


Petitioners seek this court's issuance of a writ directing the district court to grant petitioners' pretrial request for discovery, or in the alternative, a ruling from this court holding that NRS 205.320 is unconstitutional on its face and as applied. Petitioners also seek a stay of further proceedings below until such time as this court resolves the issues presented.


Having reviewed the petition submitted herein, we are not persuaded that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary writ is warranted at this time. Specifically, we conclude that an appeal from any forthcoming judgments of conviction will provide petitioners with a plain,

speedy and adequate remedy in the ordinary course of law. Accordingly, we deny the petition and the emergency request for a stay.
