ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original proper person petition for a writ of mandamus challenges the respondents' alleged refusal to provide petitioner, an inmate, with medical care. We have considered this petition, respondents' answer, and petitioner's reply, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted. Additionally, we note that addressing the issues raised in this petition would require this court to resolve disputed questions of fact for which this court is not an appropriate forum.¹ Accordingly, we deny the petition.²
