
ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR
WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION


This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a justice's court order that "banishes" petitioner from appearing before the justice's court. On December 3, 2004, we granted a temporary stay, and we directed petitioner to file a supplement within twenty days of our order and respondents to file an answer within thirty days from service of the supplement. On January 27, 2005, we received a letter from petitioner, attaching a copy of a justice's court order withdrawing the "banishment" order, as well as a motion from respondents to dismiss the petition as moot, which included a copy of the same order. Accordingly, as

the parties agree that this petition is now moot, we grant the motion and dismiss the petition. The parties shall bear their own costs and fees, if any. In light of this order, we vacate the temporary stay imposed by our December 3, 2004 order.

It is so ORDERED.
