ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL AS ABANDONED

This is an appeal from the district court's "Order Granting Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment," entered on October 22, 2004. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Jessie Elizabeth Walsh, Judge.

On March 30, 2005, the settlement judge filed a report indicating that the parties agreed to a settlement of this appeal. Accordingly, on April 7, 2005, this court entered an order directing appellant to file a stipulation or motion to dismiss this appeal or otherwise inform this court of the status of this appeal within 30 days.

On May 9, 2005, appellant filed a status report indicating that the parties needed more time to finalize their agreement. Specifically, appellant represented that "within the next two weeks, it is expected that the funds paying the settlement will be secured." Further, appellant represented that "upon payment, appellant would file a notice of abandonment/dismissal of this appeal." Accordingly, on June 24, 2005, we directed appellant to file a stipulation or motion to dismiss this appeal or to otherwise inform this court of the status of this appeal within 30 days.

To date, appellant has not responded to our June 24, 2005 order. Accordingly, cause appearing, we dismiss this appeal as abandoned.
