ORDER DENYING PETITION  
FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS


This is an original petition for a writ of habeas corpus challenging a district court order of civil contempt. Petitioner is currently serving a twenty-five day sentence in the White Pine County Jail. Petitioner seeks his immediate release from custody based on the contention that the district court lacks subject matter jurisdiction in the underlying child custody proceeding because the minor child who is the subject of the proceeding has resided outside Nevada for approximately thirteen months.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup>See NRS 125A.305(1)(a) (providing that a court of this state has jurisdiction to make an initial child custody determination if this state is the home state of the child or the child has lived in this state for six months previous to commencement of the proceedings and the child is absent from this state).

Under NRAP 21(a), the petitioner has the burden of providing this court with a statement of facts necessary for this court's understanding of all issues raised and must also attach all documents needed for this court to render its decision. Petitioner has not attached any supporting documents to his petition. Thus, based on the documents before this court, we are unable to discern the pertinent facts and procedural history in this matter. Accordingly, petitioner has failed to meet his burden under NRAP 21(a) and has not demonstrated that extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. Accordingly, we deny the petition.<sup>2</sup>
