ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On July 15, 2005, this court entered an order removing Jerome R. Bowen as counsel of record for appellant and directing appellant to retain new counsel within 30 days.¹ Our order noted that failure to retain new counsel may result in the dismissal of this appeal as abandoned. See In re Discipline of Schaefer, 117 Nev. 496, 509, 25 P.3d 191, 200 (2001) (we have consistently held that a legal entity such as a corporation cannot appear except through counsel, and we have prohibited non-lawyer principals from representing these types of entities).

To date, appellant has failed to cause new counsel to file a notice of appearance or otherwise communicate with this court. Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal as abandoned.
