

ORDER GRANTING IN PART PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This is an original proper person petition for a writ of mandamus challenging a district court order that denied petitioner's application for in forma pauperis status and to waive NRS 18.130's requirement that, upon demand by a defendant, an out-of-state plaintiff must post a cost bond with the court. We directed the real parties in interest to file an answer, which they have done.

The district court's order did not state its reasons for denying petitioner's application. Recently, in <u>Jordan v. State</u>, <u>Department of Motor Vehicles</u>, we held that an indigent plaintiff may obtain a waiver of the out-of-state cost bond. While a plaintiff's payment of the filing fee is a relevant factor to be considered, it is not dispositive with respect to whether additional costs and fees should be waived. Accordingly, we grant

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA the petition in part, and we direct the court clerk to issue a writ of mandamus directing the district court to reconsider petitioner's application in light of <u>Jordan</u>.
