

ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition. Petitioner seeks an order directing the district court to reassign the matter to a new district court judge and appoint new counsel. Petitioner claims that Judge Brent Adams disqualified himself pursuant to NRS 1.235 in October 1994 and that Judge Adams should likewise disqualify himself from participating in the new sentencing hearing ordered by the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. Petitioner further claims that the Washoe County Public Defender's Office has previously been discharged in his case, and thus, their appointment for the new sentencing hearing is a conflict of interest.

We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹ Petitioner may file appropriate documents
