

ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order concerning visitation. Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Court Division, Clark County; Gloria S. Sanchez, Judge.

Matters of custody, including visitation, rest in the district court's sound discretion.¹ This court will not disturb the district court's custody decision absent a clear abuse of discretion.² Having reviewed the record, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion. Accordingly, we
