
ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR
WRIT OF MANDAMUS, PROHIBITION, OR CERTIORARI


This original petition for a writ of mandamus, prohibition, or certiorari challenges a Nevada Tax Commission decision relating to the transportation of liquor by retail grocery stores.

We have considered this petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹ Accordingly, we deny the petition.²
