ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner argues that his appellate counsel has violated the rules of professional conduct in refusing to raise additional claims for relief and for failing to federalize his claims. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹ Petitioner is represented by counsel on direct appeal and should proceed by and through his counsel. Any claims of ineffective assistance of counsel may be raised after the resolution of his direct appeal in a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed in the district court in the first instance.²
