This is a proper person appeal from an order entered by the district court on March 24, 2005, denying appellant's motion for transcripts of an evidentiary hearing at State expense. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Donald M. Mosley, Judge. The right to appeal is statutory; where no statute or court rule provides for an appeal, no right to appeal exists.
