

## **ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL**

This appeal was docketed in this court on May 24, 2005. Accordingly, appellant was required to file the docketing statement by June 8, 2005. <u>See NRAP 14(b)</u>. Because the docketing statement was not timely filed, on June 15, 2005, this court issued a notice directing appellant to file the docketing statement within 10 days. Appellant failed to comply with this court's June 15, 2005, notice. Therefore, on August 1, 2005, we entered an order directing appellant to file and serve the docketing statement by August 11, 2005. That order cautioned appellant's counsel that failure to comply timely with our order might result in the dismissal of this appeal as abandoned. Appellant also failed to comply with our August 1, 2005, order.

On February 16, 2006, this court entered an order reinstating briefing as the parties were unable to agree to a settlement of this appeal. That order, among other things, recounted appellant's continuing failure to file the docketing statement and directed appellant file and serve the docketing statement by February 27, 2006. Our February 16, 2006, order also directed appellant to request transcripts in compliance with NRAP 9(a) by March 3, 2006. We cautioned appellant's counsel that failure to comply timely with our order might result in the imposition of sanctions,

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA including dismissal of this appeal. To date, appellant has failed to file the docketing statement and the transcript request form, or to otherwise communicate with this court.

We conclude that, due to counsel's continuing failure to comply with our appellate rules, notices and orders, dismissal of this appeal is appropriate. See NRAP 9(a)(3) and 14(c). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed as abandoned.

It is so ORDERED.
