ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks an order directing the district court to reverse and vacate an order purportedly denying his memorandum to the court.¹ We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.² It appears that petitioner is represented by counsel in the district




