This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a jury verdict. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Donald M. Mosley, Judge.

This court's preliminary review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the district court entered the judgment of conviction on June 25, 2004. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until August 11, 2005, well after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court.¹ Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
