ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL



This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court dismissing an appeal from a judgment entered in the municipal court and an order denying a second and third motion for extension of time to file a brief. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Connie J. Steinheimer, Judge.

Our review of this appeal reveals jurisdictional defects. First, appellant's case arose in the municipal court. The district court has final appellate jurisdiction over a case arising in the municipal court. Second, no statute or court rule permits an appeal from an order of the district

court denying a motion for extension of time to file a brief.² Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
