This is an appeal from an order of the district court denying appellant Kiki Washington's post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; John S. McGroarty, Judge.


In the petition, Washington presented claims of ineffective assistance of counsel. The district court found that counsel was not ineffective. The district court's factual findings regarding a claim of ineffective assistance of counsel are entitled to deference when reviewed on appeal.<sup>1</sup> Washington has not demonstrated that the district court's findings of fact are not supported by substantial evidence or are clearly

wrong. Moreover, Washington has not demonstrated that the district court erred as a matter of law. Accordingly, we


ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>2</sup>Although this court has elected to file the fast track statement and appendix submitted by Washington, we note that they do not comply with the arrangement and form requirements of the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure. Specifically, the type used in fast track statement exceeded 10 characters per inch, the documents included in appendix were not arranged chronologically, and the appendix contained more than 250 pages. See NRAP 30(c); NRAP 32(a). Counsel is cautioned that failure to comply with the requirements in the future may result in both the fast track statement and the appendix being returned, unfiled, to be correctly prepared. See NRAP 32(c). Failure to comply may also result in the imposition of sanctions by this court. NRAP 3C(n).
