
ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks an order compelling the State to disclose allegedly exculpatory evidence. Petitioner further appears to argue that he is actually innocent of the offenses. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹ A challenge to the validity of a judgment of conviction must be raised in a post-conviction petition for


