This is a proper person appeal from a judgment of conviction. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Brent T. Adams, Judge.

This court's preliminary review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the district court entered the judgment of conviction on January 9, 2004. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until September 21, 2005, well after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court.¹ Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
