


This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court denying appellant's petition for a writ of habeas corpus. First Judicial District Court, Carson City; Michael R. Griffin, Judge.

On January 15, 1989, appellant filed a proper person post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus in the district court, seeking restoration of lost good time credits. On January 24, 1989, the district court denied the petition. Appellant filed a timely notice of appeal in the district court, but the notice of appeal was not transmitted to this court until October 12, 2005. Appellant appears to have been released from the custody of the Nevada Department of Prisons and to have completed any

parole term. We therefore conclude this appeal is moot.¹ Accordingly, we
ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
