ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING APPEAL

This appeal is from the district court's denial of a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Appellant's appeal from the denial of the post-conviction petition was previously docketed in this court with the filing of a notice of appeal in Docket No. 46145.

The notice of appeal filed in Docket No. 46145 indicated that the appeal was taken from two orders of the district court: (1) an order entered by the district court on September 15, 2005, and (2) an amended order filed on October 14, 2005. However, because the record in that case did not contain an amended order, this court entered an order directing the district court to enter a written amended order and directing the district court clerk to transmit to this court a certified copy of the amended order.

Thereafter, the district court entered an amended order denying appellant's post-conviction petition. When appellant filed another notice of appeal appealing from the amended order, it was inadvertently docketed as a separate matter in the above-entitled appeal. Accordingly, we direct the clerk to administratively close the instant appeal and transfer all documents filed or received in this matter to Docket No. 46145.
