ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS


These are proper person notices of appeal from unidentified judgments of the district court. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Steven P. Elliott, Judge. We elect to consolidate these appeals for disposition.<sup>1</sup>

This court's review of these appeals reveals jurisdictional defects. In his notices of appeal, appellant stated that he was appealing from judgments of the district court. However, appellant did not


