This appeal was docketed in this court on March 17, 2006. On that date, this court issued a settlement notice informing appellant that the docketing statement must be filed within 15 days of the docketing of the appeal.<sup>1</sup> See NRAP 14(b). Because the docketing statement was not timely filed, on April 10, 2006, this court issued a notice directing appellant to file the docketing statement within 10 days. Appellant still failed to file a docketing statement.

On May 9, 2006, this court entered an order removing this appeal from the settlement conference program and reinstating briefing. Pursuant to that order, appellant was directed to file and serve the docketing statement and to request transcripts in compliance with NRAP 9 by May 19, 2006, and to file and serve the opening brief and appendix by July 10, 2006. Our order cautioned appellant that failure to comply with the order might result in the dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.


To date, appellant has failed to file the docketing statement, transcript request form, opening brief and appendix as directed in our





May 9, 2006, order. We conclude that due to appellant's continuing failure to comply with our appellate rules, notices and order, dismissal of this appeal is appropriate. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed as abandoned.
