
This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court denying a request for the appointment of counsel in post-conviction proceedings, request for an evidentiary hearing and striking a motion for release upon own recognizance or admission to bail. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Steven P. Elliott, Judge.


Our review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. The right to appeal is statutory; where no statute or court rule provides for an appeal, no right to appeal exists.¹ No statute or court rule provides for an appeal from an order denying a request for counsel, request for


