

ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of prohibition and a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks an order prohibiting: (1) the filing of documents or appearances by any counsel for the State who appears "to have a personal, pecuniary, or other bias or interest in proceedings"; (2) the district court from considering a motion without the moving party, petitioner, being allowed to file a reply to an opposition by the State; and (3) ex-parte hearings on motions. Petitioner further seeks a writ of mandamus requiring: (1) the district court to implement procedures that allow for "telephonic and or audio/visual 'appearance' by petitioner"; (2) the district court to provide copies of court orders in a timely fashion; (3) the district court to enforce prohibitions of "covert or overt appearances in cases by government attorneys who have appearance of personal and/or pecuniary interests in the outcome of such cases"; (4) the district court to implement meaningful sanctions against such government attorneys.

We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹ Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
