ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This is a proper person appeal from a district court order granting summary judgment on appellant's claims against respondent. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Douglas W. Herndon, Judge.


On September 27, 2006, this court entered an order granting a motion to withdraw filed by appellant's former counsel. That order directed appellant to retain new counsel and cause new counsel to file a notice of appearance within thirty days of that order's date. Alternatively, in the event that appellant would not be retaining new counsel, the order directed appellant to so inform this court in writing within the same time period. Because appellant failed to comply with this court's September 27 order or otherwise respond to the directives issued in that order, on November 28, 2006, this court entered an order placing this appeal into


the pilot program for civil proper person appeals<sup>1</sup> and directing appellant to file his civil appeal statement within thirty days.

Appellant's civil appeal statement was due on December 28, 2006. To date, appellant has not filed his civil appeal statement or otherwise responded to the September 27 and November 28 orders. Based on appellant's failure to comply with these orders or otherwise respond to this court's directives, we conclude that appellant has abandoned this appeal. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED
