ORDER DENYING MOTION

This is a proper person motion to compel the district court to comply with a writ of mandamus previously granted.¹ Petitioner seeks an order removing Judge Jackie Glass from the pending post-conviction proceedings, declaring as void Judge Kathy Hardcastle's order denying a motion to disqualify Judge Glass, assigning the case to a neutral judge, and sanctioning Judge Glass for the alleged failure to comply with the writ of mandamus.
