## ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus seeks to compel District Court Judge Richard A. Wagner to extend the relief granted to petitioner in the underlying case to all inmates in the custody of the Nevada Department of Corrections.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires as a duty resulting from an office, trust, or

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA station,<sup>1</sup> or to control a manifest abuse of discretion.<sup>2</sup> Mandamus is an extraordinary remedy, and it is within the discretion of this court to determine if a petition will be considered.<sup>3</sup> Having considered this petition, we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted. Accordingly, we deny the petition.<sup>4</sup>

It is so ORDERED.<sup>5</sup>
