ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. 

one another. Having reviewed the documents before this court, we conclude that extraordinary relief is not warranted.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, we


ORDER the petition DENIED.<sup>3</sup>
