This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks an order compelling the clerk of the district court to stamp and file the title sheets and return copies to petitioner Land and inmate Richard Capri,¹ an order compelling the district court to treat the petitions filed below as having been filed under common law jurisdiction, an order compelling the Justice Court to file the petitions in the Justice Court, and an order stating that Capri and Land are permitted to assist one another.
