This original proper person petition for a writ of mandamus seeks an order compelling various prison officials and employees to show cause why they have failed to enforce unspecified state laws "exempting state prisoners from . . . smoking ban laws." Petitioner also appears to challenge a prison disciplinary code citation he received for smoking in a prison bathroom.

Having reviewed the petition and supporting documentation, we have concluded that petitioner has failed to demonstrate that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary writ is warranted. Accordingly, we deny the petition.
