This is a proper person appeal from an order dismissing appellant's purported post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Lee A. Gates, Judge.

On May 24, 2004, appellant filed a proper person postconviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus in the district court. On August 30, 2004, the district court denied appellant's petition. This court affirmed the denial of appellant's petition as procedurally barred.<sup>1</sup>

On October 6, 2004, while the post-conviction appeal was pending in this court, the district court appointed counsel pursuant to NRS 34.750 to supplement appellant's petition that the district court had previously denied. No supplement or additional documents were filed, and counsel informed the district court that appellant was procedurally barred and there was nothing that could be filed on his behalf. On July 7, 2006, the district court denied post-conviction relief. This appeal followed.
