

## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from an order entitled "order on motion to confirm decision by special master following court hearing on August 1, 2006." Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Court Division, Clark County; N. Anthony Del Vecchio, Judge.

Appellant's notice of appeal was filed in this court on September 15, 2006. When the notice of appeal was filed, appellant was mailed a civil proper person appeal statement and other documents, as part of the pilot program for proper person civil appeals. As noted in the instructions accompanying the documents mailed to appellant, appellant was required to file his appeal statement within forty days from the date

his appeal was filed in this court.2 The instructions further explained that if appellant failed to file the appeal statement by that date, this court would dismiss the appeal.3

Appellant's appeal statement was due on October 25, 2006. To date, appellant has not filed an appeal statement or otherwise responded to this court's directive. Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal.

It is so ORDERED.
