This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a district court order excluding certain parties from participating in an auction of a parcel of real property.

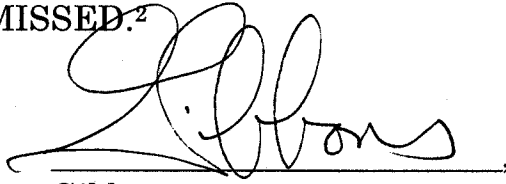

directed petitioner to, within fifteen days, show cause why this petition should not be dismissed.

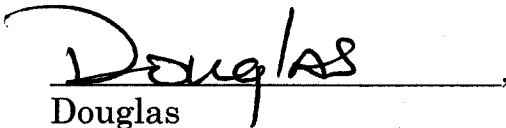
In response to our show cause order, petitioner has filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this petition. Having considered the motion, we grant it.¹

Accordingly, we

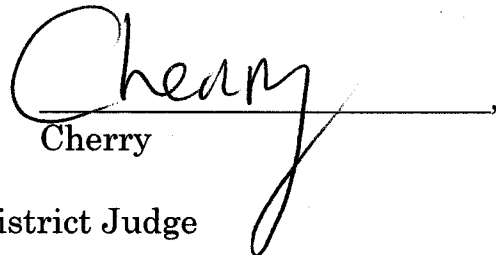
ORDER the petition DISMISSED.²
