ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from district court orders approving a class action settlement and denying appellant's petition for an alternative writ of mandamus. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Timothy C. Williams, Judge.

Our review of the documents before us reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, only an aggrieved party may appeal.¹ One who is not a party cannot appeal.² Here, appellant was not a party to the underlying action. Accordingly, we lack jurisdiction, and we
