ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS

These are appeals from an order of the district court dismissing two appeals from the justice court.¹ Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Jerome Polaha, Judge.

This court's review of these appeals revealed a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, appellant's cases arose in the justice court. The district court has final appellate jurisdiction over a case arising in the justice court.² Accordingly, on December 18, 2006, this court ordered appellant's counsel to show cause why these appeals should not be dismissed. Counsel filed a response on January 8, 2007, in which he asks
