ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order dismissing a complaint alleging violations of the federal Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA), state deceptive trade practices claims, and state tort claims. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Elizabeth Goff Gonzalez, Judge.

On October 19, 2004, Appellant Paul Edwards filed a consumer protection complaint against respondent, Coronet Enterprises, Inc., et. al., based on a one-page fax received on his home fax machine sometime on or about October 29, 2002, which solicited Edwards to contact Coronet for a mortgage offer. Edwards has filed a series of similar lawsuits against other persons or entities.

In his complaint for damages and injunctive relief, Edwards claimed that Coronet: 1) violated the federal Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA) as enumerated in 47 U.S.C. § 227; 2) committed a deceptive trade practice in violation of NRS 598.0915-25; and 3) committed the common-law torts of conversion and private nuisance. Edwards sought both injunctive relief and damages in excess of \$10,000.

The district court dismissed Edwards' complaint on December 14, 2004, without prejudice. Thereafter, Edwards appealed the dismissal to this court, and we affirmed the district court's dismissal. Edwards then re-filed his complaint on February 15, 2006. The district court ultimately dismissed the action with prejudice and this appeal followed. We conclude that the district court correctly dismissed the matter. Accordingly we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
