This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks an order compelling his trial counsel to send him his trial transcripts or an order compelling the district court to order the preparation of the transcripts and inform him of the costs of the transcripts.

We have considered the documents presented to this court, and we conclude that our intervention is not warranted at this time.<sup>1</sup> It appears from the documents submitted to this court that petitioner filed a motion for counsel to withdraw and transfer the case file and that the motion was granted. Petitioner should seek enforcement of that order in the district court.<sup>2</sup> It appears that the remittitur from the direct appeal issued on October 31, 2006, and thus, appellant has one year from that
