
ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus and a writ of prohibition. It appears that petitioner challenges prison disciplinary proceedings, and petitioner seeks an order: (1) directing his transfer to the Southern Desert Correctional Center; (2) expunging his inmate file; (3) appointing counsel; (4) compensating him in the amount of at least \$850,000; (5) replacing personal property taken from his cell; and (6) prohibiting any violation of rights during the remainder of his incarceration. We have reviewed the documents before this court, and we

conclude that this court's intervention by extraordinary writ is not warranted.¹ Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
