ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

After the settlement judge filed a report indicating that the parties had agreed to a settlement of this matter, this court entered an order directing appellant to file a motion or stipulation to dismiss this appeal or to otherwise inform this court of the status of this appeal. In response, appellant has submitted 2 proper person documents.

One document is a "Notice of Association of Counsel," purporting to substitute appellant in proper person in the place of attorney Stephen N. Scheerer as counsel of record for this appeal. That document is also signed by attorney Scheerer indicating that he consents to the "association of counsel." We elect to treat that document as a motion to withdraw as counsel of record, and we grant that motion.¹ <u>See</u> NRAP 46(d), SCR 46(1).
