
ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS


This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order denying a motion to amend the complaint in the underlying case to add petitioners, in their capacities as special administrators of their son's estate, as parties-plaintiffs.


On May 21, 2007, petitioners and several real parties in interest filed a "stipulation" for voluntary dismissal of this petition. As

the “stipulation” was not signed by all parties, we treat it as a motion to voluntarily dismiss this petition. We grant the motion and dismiss this petition.¹ The parties shall bear their own costs and fees, if any.
