ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This appeal was initiated by a proper person notice of appeal. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Michelle Leavitt, Judge.


This court's preliminary review of this appeal reveals jurisdictional defects. On January 25, 2007, appellant filed a proper person notice of appeal in the district court. The notice of appeal fails to designate any appealable orders. To the extent that appellant is attempting to appeal from the judgment of conviction, that order was entered on March 23, 2006, and the notice of appeal is therefore untimely. An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court.<sup>1</sup>


