
ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is an original petition for a writ of certiorari or mandamus, challenging petitioner's misdemeanor battery conviction. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Valerie Adair, Judge.


We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is
