ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order dismissing a petition for judicial review. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; J. Charles Thompson, Judge.

On August 22, 2007, this court entered an order that, among other things, granted appellant's motion for an extension of time to file her civil proper person appeal statement and transcript request form. Appellant was given fifteen days from that order's date to file her transcript request form and thirty days from that order's date to file her civil proper person appeal statement. Our August 22 order cautioned appellant that her failure to file her appeal statement within that time may result in the dismissal of this appeal. Appellant's civil proper person appeal statement was due on September 21, 2007. When appellant failed to file her appeal statement within that time, respondent filed a motion to dismiss this appeal based on appellant's failure to prosecute the appeal. To date appellant has neither filed her civil proper person appeal statement nor filed an opposition to respondent's motion to dismiss. Accordingly, we conclude that appellant has abandoned this appeal, and we
