ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order dismissing the underlying case pursuant to NRCP 41(b). Third Judicial District Court, Churchill County; Robert E. Estes, Judge.

In <u>Salman v. Newell</u>¹ this court held that "no rule or statute permits a [non-lawyer] to represent any other person, a company, a trust, or any other entity" in either the district court or this court.² Additionally, in <u>Salman</u>, we also held that an entity may not proceed in proper person before this court.³ Here, Linwood Edward Tracy, Jr., a non-lawyer, has filed an appeal on behalf of World Prayers Answered. Tracy himself admits that he is "acting [o]n behalf of" World Prayers Answered in the document he filed in this court on August 17, 2007. Because Tracy may
